2. *The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks.*
3. *A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines].*
4. *Termination of the agreement*
[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

LT VILNIUS01:

2. *The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks after the deadline.*
3. *A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.*
4. *Termination of the agreement*
The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

Each numerical grade corresponds to a qualitative grade as follows: Fail (FX, F): 1- 4; Sufficient (E) - 5; Satisfactory (D) - 6; Good (C) - 7, 8; Very Good (B) - 9, Excellent (A) - 10.LT*

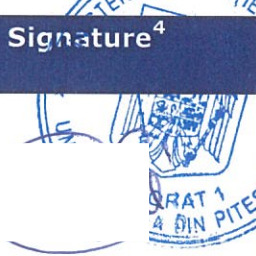
